WILL OF WILLIAM ENTWISTLE No. 6157/1

SUPREME COURT OF NSW, PROBATE DIVISION

29 September 1864 Probate of the Will was granted to JOSEPH ENTWISTLE and MARY JANE ENTWISTLE an executrix and one of the executors with leave reserved to WILLIAM SPRING the other executor to come in and prove named therein. Testator died 29 July 1864.

The Last Will and Testament of WILLIAM ENTWISTLE, dated 23 June 1862, reads as follows:

"This is the Last Will and Testament of me WILLIAM ENTWISTLE of Parramatta in the Colony of New South Wales Storekeeper FIRST I DIRECT all my just debts funeral and testamentary expences to be paid and satisfied as soon as conveniently may be after my decease. SECONDLY I am possessed of two Brick Built Cottages or tenements lying situated or being in O'Connell Street in the Town of Parramatta aforesaid AND all and singular the houses hold funiture plate linen China Books, Pictures and everything I may be possessed of at the time of my decease I GIVE DEVISE and bequeath unto My Eight Children namely JOSEPH ENTWISTLE, my daughter ELLEN now the Wife of WILLIAM SPRING, WILLIAM ENTWISTLE, ALFRED ENTWISTLE, ANN ENTWISTLE, MARY JANE ENTWISTLE and SARAH ENTWISTLE and JAMES ENTWISTLE And my Will and desire is that none of the said property shall be sold until my youngest daughter SARAH ENTWISTLE shall attain the age of twenty-one years THEN and in such case I will and desire that the before mentioned premises be disposed of and that my said Eight Children before mentioned receive share and share alike from proceeds thereof AND thereby nominate and appoint my said Son JOSEPH ENTWISTLE, WILLIAM SPRING, and my daughter MARY JANE ENTWISTLE to be Executors and Executrix of this my Will and hereby revoking all former and other Wills be me heretofore made I declare this to be my last Will and Testament IN WITNESS thereof I the said WILLIAM ENTWISTLE have hereunto set my hand the Twenty third day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty two....."
